



Crazy Eights rules

Crazy Eights is a classic card game that is easy to learn and fun for players of all ages. The goal of the game is to be the first player to get rid of all your cards by matching the top card of the discard pile by suit or rank. Eights are special cards that can be played at any time and allow the player to change the current suit.

How to play Crazy Eights

Crazy Eights is typically played with 2–5 players using a standard 52-card deck. Each player is dealt a hand of cards, and the remaining cards form a draw pile. The top card of the draw pile is placed face up to start the discard pile.

Gameplay

Players take turns playing one card that matches the suit or rank of the top card on the discard pile. If a player cannot play a valid card, they must draw cards from the draw pile until they can play. An eight may be played at any time, and when played, the player chooses which suit continues.

How to win

The first player to get rid of all their cards wins the game. In some versions, remaining players score penalty points based on the cards left in their hands, and the game continues until a target score is reached.
