



## Spit card game rules and how to play

The **Spit card game** (also known as *Speed* in some regions) is a fast-paced two-player game built on reflexes, quick decisions, and constant movement.

The goal is simple: get rid of all your cards before your opponent by placing them onto shared center piles in ascending or descending order.

Unlike most classic card games, Spit has no turns. Both players play at the same time, which makes understanding the flow of the game just as important as reacting quickly.

### **Setup and preparations**

Before the game begins, both players need to build their layout correctly. A clean setup is key, because the game moves very fast once it starts.

#### **Game setup overview**

Element	Details
Players	2
Deck	Standard 52-card deck (no Jokers)
Objective	Be the first to get rid of all cards

#### **How to set up the game**

- Shuffle the deck and deal 26 cards to each player
- Create five piles: 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 cards (top card face up)
- Remaining cards become your Spit pile
- Leave space in center for two shared piles

### **Spit gameplay rules step by step**

#### **1. Start the round**

Both players say "Spit!" and flip one card from their Spit pile into the center.

#### **2. Play cards as fast as possible**

Place cards one rank higher or lower. Example: 6 connects with 5 or 7.

#### **3. Keep your layout active**

Replace empty piles immediately from your Spit pile.

#### **4. No moves available**

Say "Spit!" again and place new cards to continue.

#### **5. Ending the round**

Winner takes smaller pile, opponent takes the other.

### **Winning the game**

The game continues over multiple rounds, with players reducing their total number of cards each time. Eventually, one player runs out of cards completely. That player wins the game.

## Tips to play Spit faster and smarter

Spit is a game of speed, but playing smart can give you a real advantage over time.

Stay focused on both center piles instead of locking onto one. Opportunities appear quickly, and missing them slows you down.

Use both hands when possible. This allows you to react faster and play multiple moves in quick succession.

Keep your piles organized and easy to reach. A messy layout can cost valuable seconds.

Train your pattern recognition. The faster you recognize which cards can be played, the more pressure you put on your opponent.

Most importantly, stay calm under pressure. Panic leads to mistakes, and in a fast game like Spit, mistakes are costly.

## Overview of the Spit card game rules

Rule	Summary
Players	2 players
Deck	Standard 52-card deck
Setup	Five layout piles and one Spit pile per player
Gameplay	Both players play at the same time
Matching	One rank higher or lower (no suits)
Layout	Always maintain five active piles
Reset	Say "Spit!" when no moves are possible
Round end	First player to clear all cards wins the round
Pile rule	Winner takes the smaller center pile
Game win	First player to run out of all cards wins
